



Year 4 - Autumn term 1

What are we learning...



ENGLISH

In English, the children will be writing information texts and instructions about how they could tame their own dragon. Then we'll be moving on to writing inspired by our class text - Boudicca!

MATHS

In Maths, the children will be developing their understanding of place value, focusing on areas such as rounding, number lines, and comparing numbers.

SCIENCE

In Science, the children will be focusing on grouping and classifying living things. More specifically, looking at the features of each group, including invertebrates and vertebrates, as well as flowering and non-flowering plants.

HISTORY

In History this term we will be digging deeper into the legacy the Romans left behind. We'll be exploring timelines, leaders, conflict and disaster

MUSIC

The children will be exploring how they can utilise and apply their understanding of rhythm, pulse and beat?

ART

In Art, the children will be looking at Mosaics - investigating where they originated followed by designing and creating their own Roman Mosaic.

COMPUTING

Our children will apply their knowledge and understanding of networks, to appreciate the internet as a network of networks which need to be kept secure.

RE

In RE, the children will be learning about the main beliefs of Hinduism, how worship is practiced at home and at the Mandir, as well as understanding what happens during Diwali.

MFL

This half term, the children will learn how to recall and pronounce the French phonetic sounds 'CH', 'OU', 'ON', and 'OI', as well as learn key verbs.

PSHE

The children will be looking at 'Being Me In My World' with a key focus on democracy and the way in which this can benefit our community.

PE
