What are we learning...



ENGLISH

In English, the children will be looking at character profiles, shape poetry and letter writing. There will be ongoing SPAG skills taught.

MATHS

In Maths the children will be developing their understanding of number and place value, addition and subtraction, multiplication and division and properties of shapes.

SCIENCE

In Science, the children will be exploring the uses of everyday materials. They will be asking and investigating scientific questions and learning about significant real life Scientists.

HISTORY/GEOGRAPHY

In History, the children will be learning about The Gunpowder Plot. In Geography the children will be learning about London landmarks, UK countries and capital cities of the UK.

MUSIC

The children will be exploring rhythms, creating call and response music and playing melodies on tuned percussion.

ART

In Art, the children will be developing their drawing skills and studying the works of Rembrandt.

COMPUTING

In Computing, children will be exploring what Information Technology is, develop their word processing skills and E-Safety will be taught throughout.

RE

In RE, the children will be looking at the key beliefs in Islam and the Christian festivals of Harvest and Christmas.

DT

The children will be exploring and using mechanisms to design, make and evaluate their own moving vehicle.
